2. Tentative Guideline for Oral Presentation:

For Individual Presenter(s): Assigned time for oral presentation may change according to the final programme. However, the programme committee is considering that we can secure 25-30

minutes, including question and discussion for one presentation.

For Panel Presenter(s): Time of one panel depends on the number of presenters. The panel consisted of 4 or 5 presentation may take 2 hours or 2 and a quarter hours. The panel of more presenters may be 3 hours. Time distribution for each presentation will be decided by the organizer/chair. Please contact your organizer.
